## MEADOWDALE HIGH SCHOOL

Meadowdale High School is one of four comprehensive high schools in the Edmonds School District. Located about 15 miles north of Seattle. Meadowdale High School is accredited by the Northwest Association of Schools and is a member of the National Association for College Admission Counseling and complies with the NACAC Statement of Principles of Good Practice.

## SCHOOL CALENDAR

The school calendar is composed of two 18-week semesters over 180 school days. Meadowdale High School's schedule is a modified block with three ninety-eight minute class periods four days per week and six fifty minute periods one day per week. Core courses are taught over the entire school year.

## CURRICULUM

Honors level courses are offered in the areas of English, Social Studies, Mathematics and Science beginning in the Freshman year. Meadowdale High School offers Advanced Placement courses in: English Literature and Composition, English Language and Composition, United States History, American Government, European History, World History, Calculus, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental

Science and Advanced Studio Art. College in the High School courses are taught in Calculus and European History.

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

One half credit is awarded for each subject completed with a passing grade each semester. Twenty-two (22.0) total credits including 1.0 credit in Art, 3.5 credits in English, 3.5 credits in Social Studies, 2.0 credits in Mathematics, 2.0 credits in Science, 2.0 credits in Career-Technical (.5 credit required in Contemporary Living), 1.5 credit in Physical Education and .5 credit in Health. A Senior Culminating Project is presented for graduation. Beginning with the Class of 2008, 4.0 credits will be required in English and Math must be completed at the Integrated Math 2 level or higher for graduation.

## GRADING AND CLASS RANK

All grades earned at Meadowdale High School, and transfer credits from previous schools, are computed into the cumulative grade point average. The official grade point average is computed using semester grades from all classes. The class rank is determined using all semester grades. **Both the cumulative grade point average and class rank are unweighted.**
