

Jazz Ensemble – Lionel Hampton - Behavior Agreement

Every student and their parents(s)/Guardian(s) must read and sign the following prior to travel. The fun and positive experience of traveling depends on everyone understanding the expectations and agreeing to adhere to them. Please help make it a great time for everyone by following these rules closely.

1. Be considerate and respectful of people and property at all times.
2. Students are to follow the directions of all adult chaperones. Discipline will be administered by Mr. Bergevin only. Parents chaperones do not have this responsibility but can help with supervision.
3. All school rules regarding drugs, alcohol, and tobacco apply, as do school and activity conduct code consequences. No smoking at any time on this trip.
4. For safety, students will always be with at least one other student or adult. There will be times when students will be closely chaperoned (concerts, etc) and times when they will have a little less supervision (recreation time, etc.) – students are responsible for behaving appropriately in all situations.
5. Chaperones must be with at least two students at any time, unless it is their own child (not alone with a child). Students of opposite genders will not be permitted in each other's rooms for any reason.
6. Dress appropriately for the occasion. The director will determine what is appropriate. We are representing Edmonds-Woodway High School. When in the audience; please don't put your feet on chairs in front of you and don't visit during music as we are surrounded by other interested audience members.
7. Students are responsible for all personal possessions. Neither the Edmonds School District, Edmonds-Woodway High School, nor the Music Department will reimburse students for lost or stolen items.
8. For safety reasons, students must be in their assigned sleeping space between 11:00 pm and 7 am. Lights out will be at 11:00. Everyone will need his or her sleep to handle the busy schedule. After lights out, doors will be secured and if students leave their room for any reason Mr. Bergevin will be informed and consequences will be administered.
9. Do not bring your gaming consoles (ninetendo, xbox, etc) for after hours entertainment. If discovered, these will be collected and returned at the end of the trip.

Consequences for violating the travel behavior guidelines include, but are not limited to:

- Parents coming to pick students up – the trip at their own expense.
- Suspension or expulsion from school and suspension from all but in-school music events.

If an illegal activity occurs, the local police will be notified and the students will accept the consequences.

Mr. Bergevin will administer appropriate and prompt discipline with input from appropriate chaperones.

Violations of the travel behavior guidelines will leave the student at risk of losing their music letter for the year and possibly failing the class.
